## **FOCUS: Firefighter Occupational Cancer Understanding and Support**

We have known for a while that the leading cause of death among firefighters is cancer. Recent research shows an increased risk of **skin melanoma**, **other skin cancers**, and **prostate cancer**, and higher death rates in **non-Hodgkin lymphoma**, **testicular** and **rectal** cancer.
